ISLAMIC & CIVIL MARRIAGE POLICY

We are honored to host couples and their families for the Islamic (Nikaah) and Civil marriage ceremony at our Mosque. To ensure that the ceremony is conducted smoothly and respectfully, the following guidelines are in place for all families wishing to conduct their marriage in our Mosque:

TIME SLOT

The Islamic marriage ceremony will be allotted a 1-hour time slot. Please ensure that the ceremony starts and ends on time. If the ceremony exceeds the allotted time due to delays caused by the family or guests, the ceremony will be canceled. A new date must be booked, and a new payment will be required.

FOOD AND DRINKS

To maintain the sanctity and cleanliness of the Mosque, no food or drinks are permitted in the prayer halls or other areas, except for water and dates or sweets (mithais). We kindly ask guests to respect this policy and refrain from bringing any other refreshments.

RESPECT FOR MOSQUE ENVIRONMENT

All attendees are expected to dress modestly and behave with respect the sanctity of the Mosque. No excessive noise is permitted, as the Mosque is a place of worship and reflection. Please be mindful of the sacred nature of the surroundings.

GUEST NUMBERS

Families must provide confirmation of the number of guests attending the ceremony ahead of time. This helps us manage space and ensure comfort for all attendees. Kindly inform the administration of the number of guests in advance when booking the date.

DECORATION

No decorations are permitted inside the Mosque. We ask that families respect the sacred environment and refrain from any form of decoration, including balloons etc.

RESPECTFUL BEHAVIOR

As the ceremony is held within the Mosque, all participants and guests should observe appropriate decorum. Guests must leave the Mosque immediately following the ceremony to ensure that the space is vacated for normal daily prayers to resume.

By adhering to these guidelines, we can ensure that the Marriage ceremony is conducted in a manner that is respectful and in keeping with the sanctity of the Mosque. Should you have any further questions or require clarification, please contact the Mosque office.
